KS2 2018 Results

Average progress is calculated by grouping children into attainment groups according to their KS1 assessments. The children's KS2 scores are then compared with the average for this group. These figures kept us well within floor standards which were: -5 in maths, -5 in reading and -7 in writing.

Average progress scores

The scaled scores are calculated from the KS2 test outcomes. The range is 80 – 120, with 100 being the expected standard.

Where percentages are involved, it is important to bear in mind the size of the cohort size in Sennen School. With 15 pupils in year 6 in 2018 each child makes up 6.66%, meaning that numbers can vary greatly from national averages. The combined line represents the percentage of children who achieved the expected level in reading, writing and maths.
