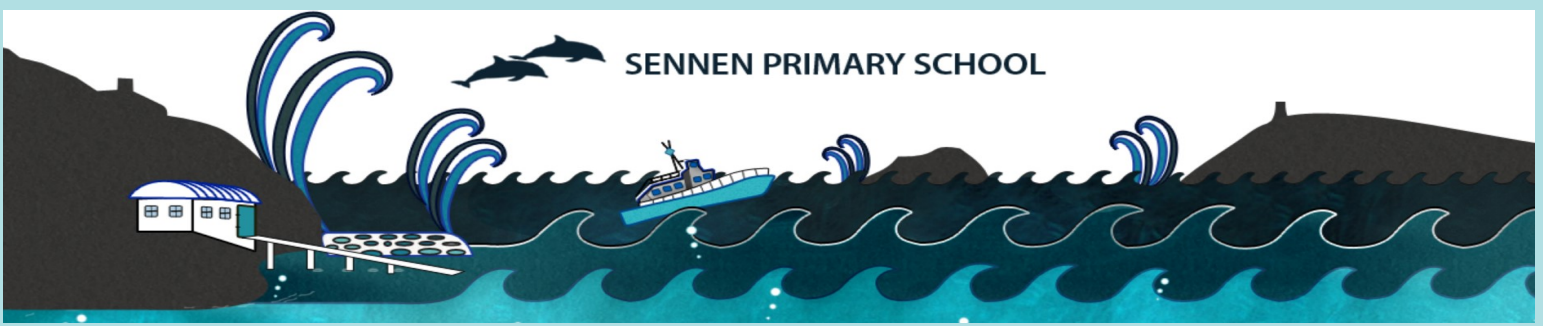

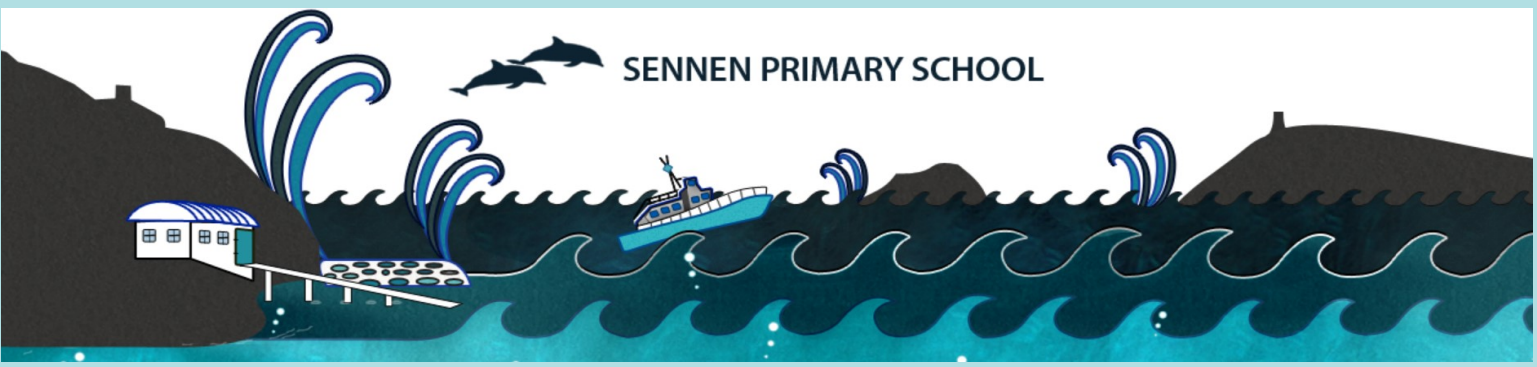

The children have made rockets out of recycling, aliens with K'Nex and have loved the train sets as well as the babies. We even had a twin birth!

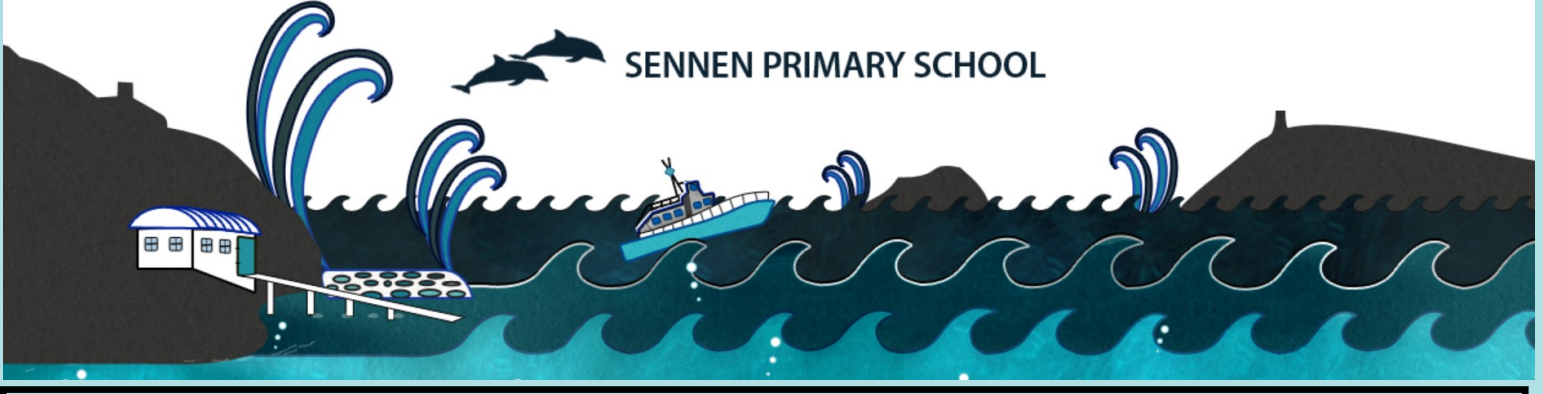

Longships class round up

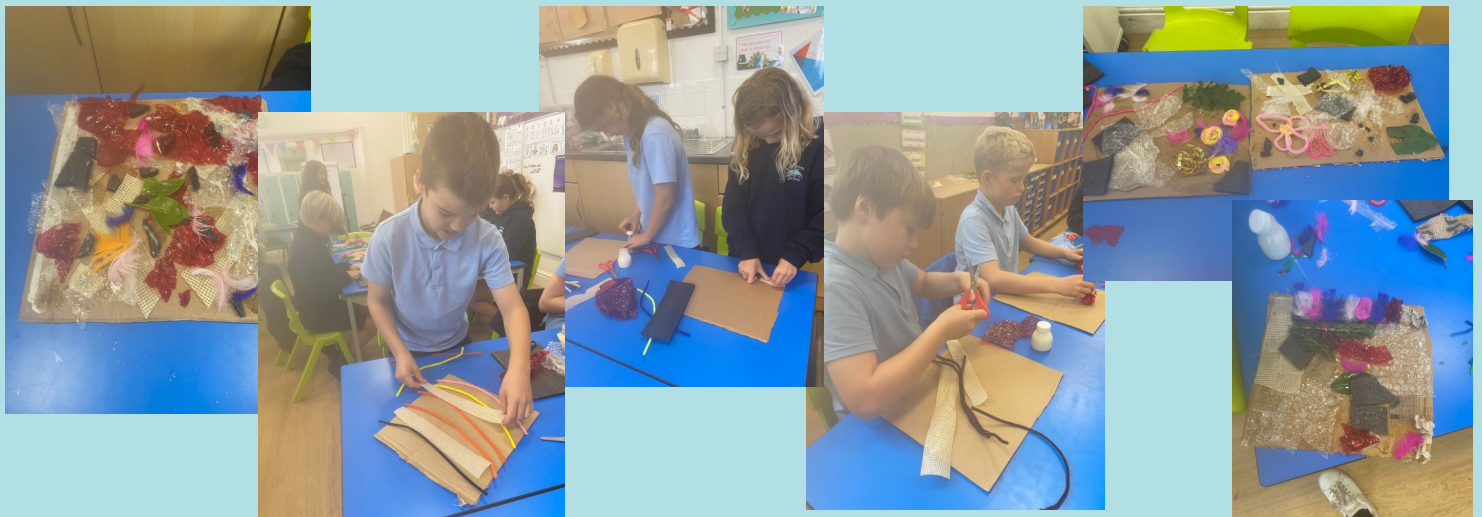

Cowloe class round up

Cowloe have been working hard in Maths, finishing off their place value topic with negative numbers and they have a great understanding. In English we are planning and writing our Sci-Fi story based on a clip from Avatar. We have been focusing on adding detail using expanded noun phrases and parenthesis. We have also been revising and learning all about the different types of noun. We have been learning about Earth and the planets and this week we focused on the different phases of the Moon. In Art, the children have experimented with different textures and created a template which they will use to print next week. The children are given spellings, reading and a piece of home work every week.
