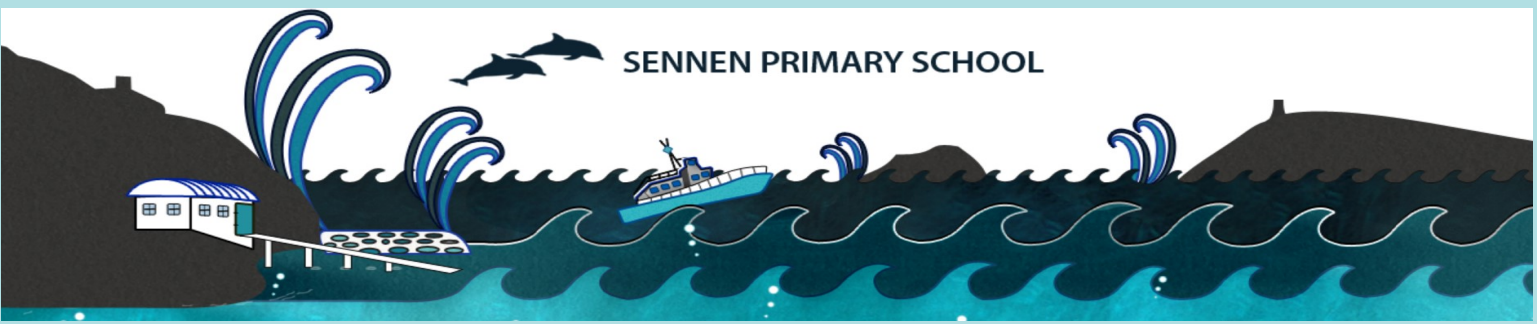

There has been some fantastic learning going on in school this week! We pride ourselves on our whole curriculum and love seeing children engaged in so many different activities.

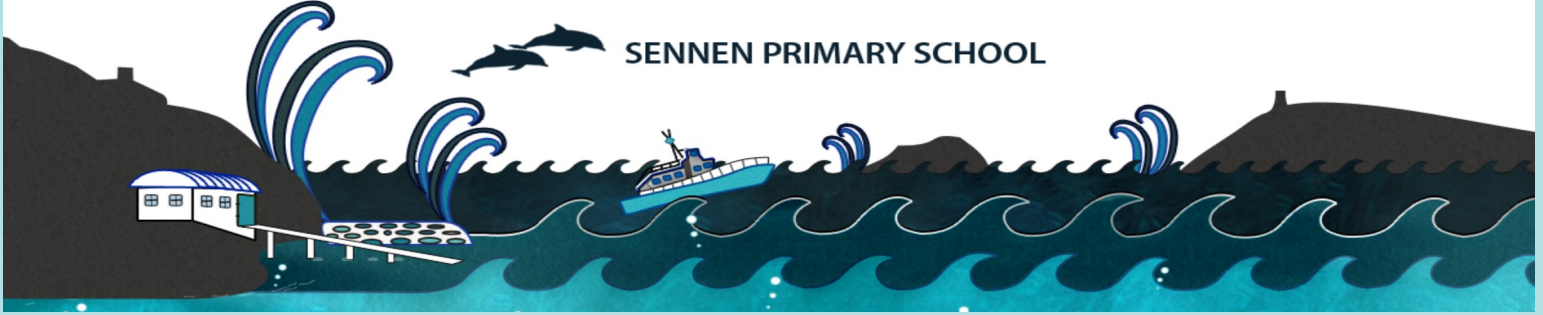
Brisons class have been learning about colour theory in art. They learned what primary colours were and how they could mix them to form secondary colours.

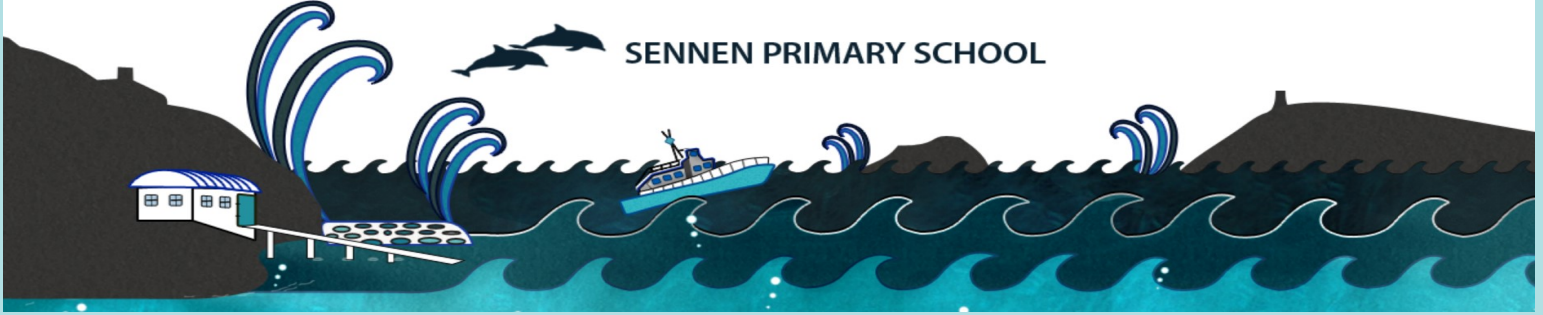
