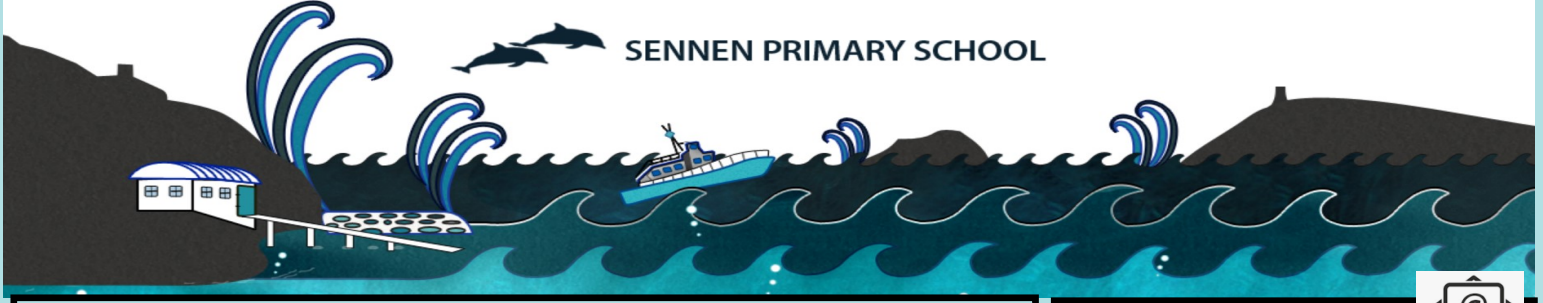
Rugby
