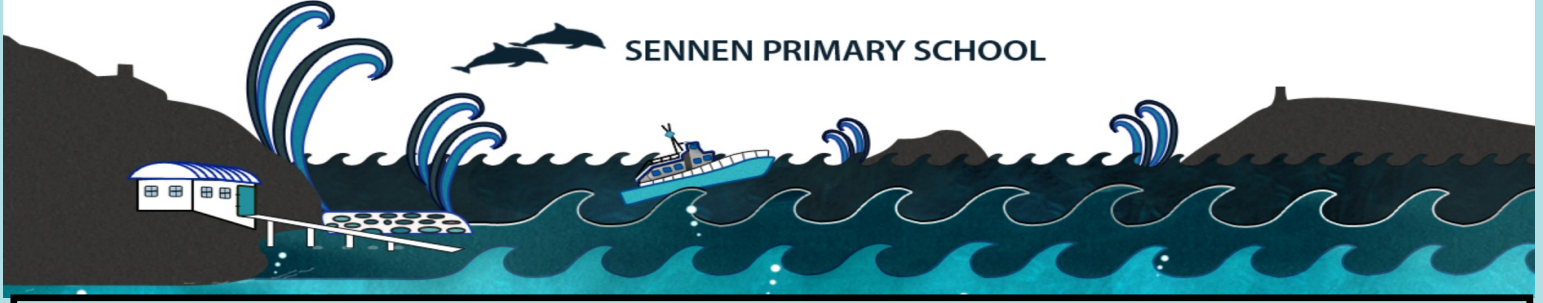

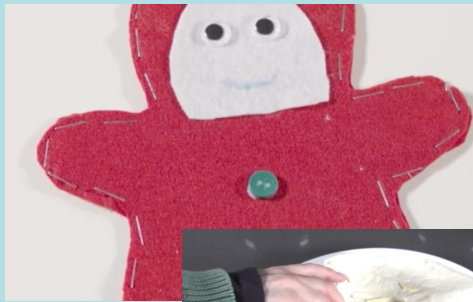
Curriculum focus

Over the last year, we have worked very hard on our wider curriculum to ensure that pupils see that there are many different ways to excel. I want to raise awareness of the work going on in school by highlighting a different subject in each newsletter. This week the focus is Design and Technology.

The national curriculum for design and technology aims to ensure that all pupils:

- Develop the creative, technical and practical expertise needed to perform everyday tasks confidently to participate successfully in an increasingly technological world.
- Build and apply a repertoire of knowledge, understanding and skills in order to design and make high-quality prototypes and products for a wide range of user's critique.
- Evaluate and test their ideas and products and the work of others.
- Understand and apply the principles of nutrition and learn how to cook.

On our website, we have full progression documents and long term plans so that you can find out more about our intentions and what your child will be learning.
