

Headteacher update

What a fun-filled term we have had! Not only have the children worked incredibly hard, they have grabbed lots of different opportunities and made the very best out of them. We have worked with community groups such as the Minack and PK Porthcurno, and enjoyed sports coaching from Penzance Tennis Club. We have decided that we will be running the club for KS2 next term, and KS1 in term 4. This will now be free of charge. It will focus on a specific sport (Football in the spring and cricket in the summer) in the hope that we can arrange some matches.






KS1 & EYFS performances
