Uniform

The uniform policy has now been updated and is available on our website here: <u>Sennen Community Primary Academy - Policies</u>

We have made the decision to tighten up on a few things, particularly footwear, and I wanted to explain why. After Covid, we made the decision to be a bit more lenient on uniform as money was tight and we just wanted the children to come back in without putting the pressure on families to go out and buy certain things. Over the last year, this seems to have changed, and pupils are wearing rather expensive footwear to school. This is causing a lot of pressure at home for some families to 'keep up' with what others have. This is not the intention of school uniform. The uniform policy now states either black school shoes or plain black trainers. Most other things have stayed the same, it just now states that cycling shorts are not part of everyday uniform. Mrs Tindall will be explaining the policy to the children in assembly on Monday so that the children know what the expectations are going to be.

There will be a pre loved rail at the market on Friday as we have lots of uniform of good quality that can be reused.

Transition

Whole school transition will be on Tuesday morning, with an extra transition for Aire class (into Brisons) on Wednesday afternoon, when we will also be welcoming our new reception children into the school. Being such a small school, we are lucky that the children already know the staff in the school well, but this is a good opportunity for the children to go into their new classroom and talk about their strengths and any concerns or worries they may have.
