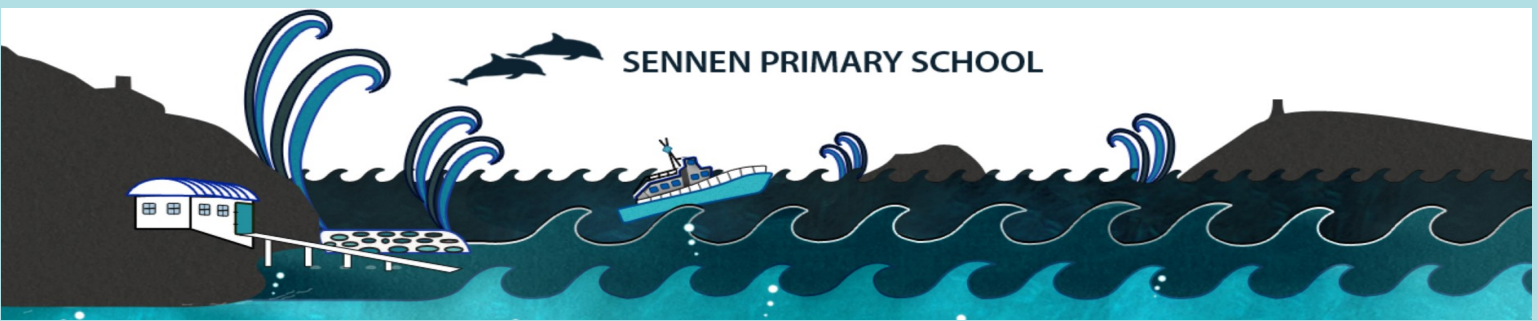

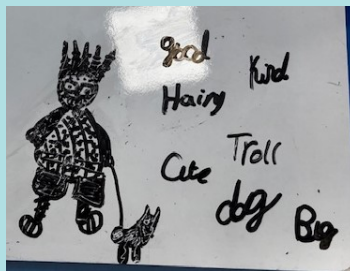

Brisons Class

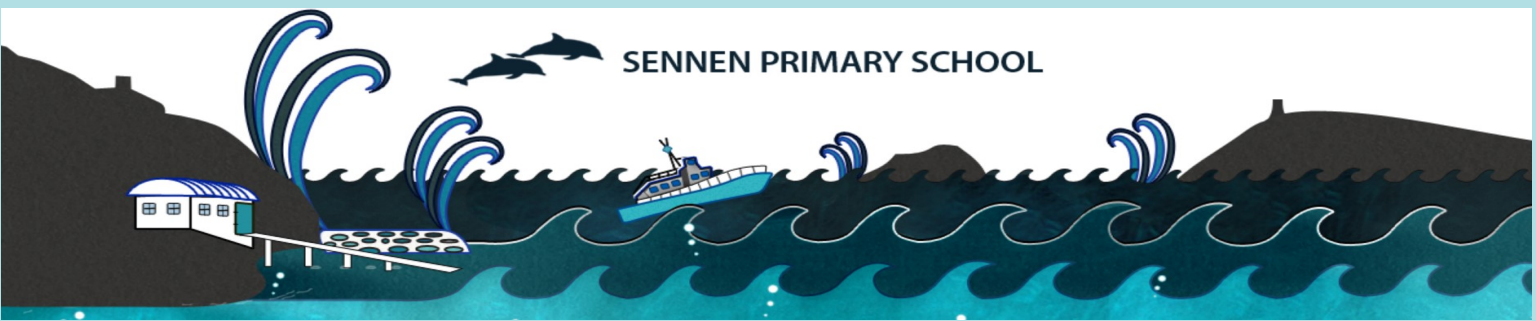

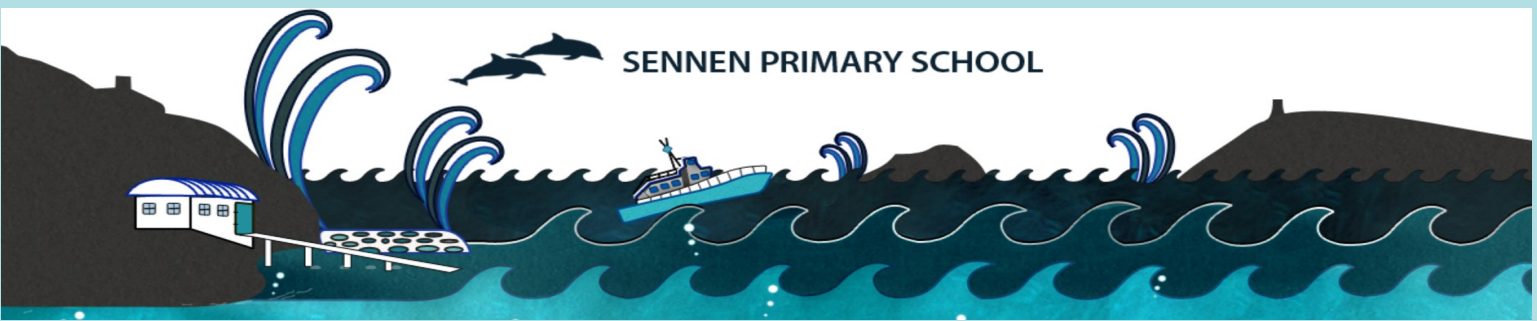

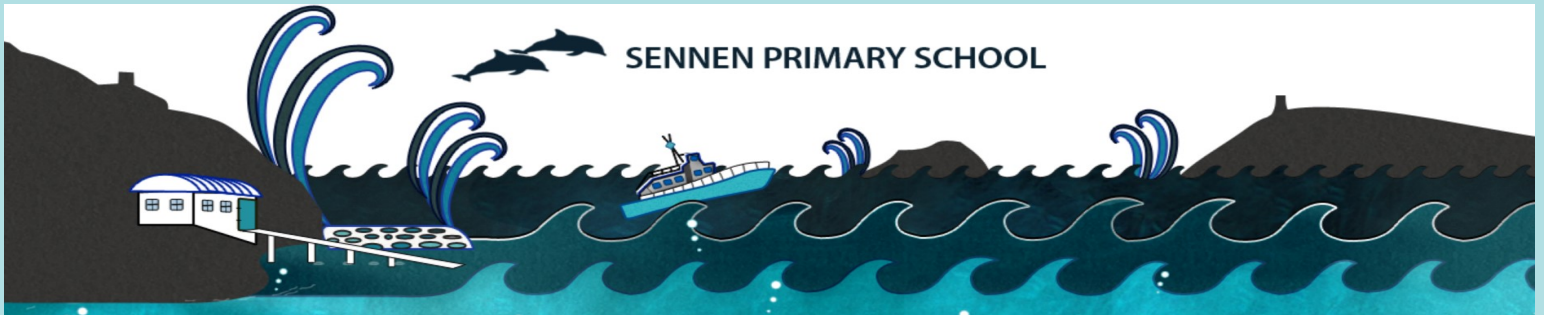
