



Headteacher update

On **Monday 12th December** we have our KS2 (Longships and Cowloe) performance in the community centre. We aim to start this swiftly at **1pm**. Afterwards, we will have a few items for sale that the children have been making in school. At **around 2.30** we have a very exciting treat! RNAS Culdrose have arranged for Father Christmas to arrive in a helicopter. Our plan is that everyone hangs around after the performance, gathers on the field and waits for the surprise. FOSS have kindly bought a selection box for him to give to each child. Everyone is welcome to join us and once finished, you can take your child(ren) straight away. **We ask that you please keep this as a surprise.**

On **Tuesday 13th September** KS1 (Brisons and Aire class) will do their performance in the Community Centre. We aim to start at 1.30. As with KS2, we will have some items for sale afterwards that the children have been making in school. You can take your child straight afterwards.

We have been invited up to the church in Sennen for a Christingle service on **Wednesday 14th December** at 2.45. Parents and families are welcome to join us and we ask that you collect your child from the church at 3.15 instead of school. There is plenty of parking at the back of the church for those who need it.

As some of you may know, we have a tradition of asking parents to provide a book as a gift from Santa for our class parties. We usually find that the children love these and really enjoy sitting looking through them together. Our class parties are on **Thursday 15th December** in the afternoon, so if you could send us a wrapped, named book by **Wednesday 14th** that would be great. If this is going to be a challenge for you financially, please do get in touch with me so that we can put something in place to ensure no child misses out. **Christmas dinner will also be on this day.**

At the end of term, we often have an early finish. This year, we are very aware that we are finishing rather early for the holidays (**Friday 16th**) so are reluctant to do a blanket early finish. What we are proposing is that class teachers use it as their Christmas treat afternoon for earning rewards through the term, but that if you would like to pick your child up at 1.30, you are welcome to (for instance if you plan to go away and want to beat traffic). All we ask is that you let us know beforehand so that we know how many we have in school, to help plan activities.
