We've had a ground-breaking couple of weeks in Aire Class with, most notably, our first "proper day out" to Newquay Aquarium. This was organised in response to the children's' keen interest in sea creatures. Needless to say, they learnt a lot - did you know that crabs have taste buds on their back legs?! The children have also been amazing in Phonics with their word reading and writing recently! They have now learnt their first set of "specials friends" (sounds made up of two letters) and will be moving onto reading short stories next week. In Maths, we have focused on numbers 4 and 5, exploring their composition and representing them. Last week we focused on the text "Little Glow" which looks at celebrations across the globe. The children enjoyed doing fireworks paintings using salt and leaning a fantastic fireworks song! They have also found time to learn about Remembrance Day, make willow and wool poppies, read "Tiddler", make fishing rods and edible sparklers and use a storm kettle to cook up hot chocolate. Epic!

This week, Longships have been working so hard on adding with an exchange. They showed great teamwork when talking about their strategies with their partner and using the manipulatives.


We have almost finished our very inventive 'Just So' stories and can't wait to edit and produce a final draft next week ready to share with you all at Parents' Week.


Our predator topic has also had us considering animal skeletons and grouping them into vertebrates and invertebrates. A great week finished off with some soggy but jovial Forest School.
