

### Headteacher's Message

On Monday I had the privilege of taking 10 children to the Penwith Schools' cross country competition. They all ran their socks off, which made me so proud, but I was even more proud of their attitude and spirit. They cheered each other on and built each other up and all left full of smiles. We will be joining the next round in the Spring so will start a running club after Christmas to get practising!

Forest school was wonderful this afternoon. Longships class had the pleasure of going to a very special site over in Morvah where they had a lot of fun playing in the mud! A huge thank you to Lisa at Higher Keigwin Farm for making us feel so welcome. We didn't do very well with our timings though, which I apologise for, hopefully next week will run smoother!

Parent Consultations—These will be held next week on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday (depending on the class) after school. We have made the decision to hold these face to face. We ask that you wear your mask (unless exempt) while waiting for your appointment, but you can remove it once in class as the chairs will be an appropriate distance apart. We ask that you do not attend if you are feeling unwell. If you would prefer, we are more than happy to contact you by telephone, just let us know and we can make sure that a phone is available.

**Residentials**—we have booked our year 5&6 residential trip! It is fantastic to be able to offer this again this year, it is such a memorable experience for children and staff alike. Mrs Tindall will be sending out a letter next week for those interested. We are also intending on doing a shorter residential trip for years 3&4, and an evening event for years 1&2 in the summer term.

Christmas events—We are so excited at the prospect of holding Christmas events this year. Each class is going to be doing a performance so get ready to learn some songs at home! We have decided to hold these performances as 2 smaller shows this year, one for KS1 & Reception, and one for KS2. We have made the decision not to hold a Christmas fair in the traditional sense this year. The school building is very small and it is usually a very popular event. Instead, we will hold 'mini fairs' as part of the Christmas productions, or one evening after school where the children can sell their crafts. We will have a tombola, a raffle and refreshments available at the productions. We will send out more information nearer the time. We are also waiting to confirm the date for the party but hope to hold it at Lands End as we have in previous years.

**Children in Need**— The official date for Children in Need is Friday, but as most of the school is out at Forest School or swimming, we have decided to hold our fundraising event on Thursday. On Thursday, children are welcome to come into school in their PJs, or their own clothes, for a donation towards the charity. After School, we are also hoping to hold a fundraising event in place of High Five Netball and Multi-sports, I will send some more information out about it on Monday.

**WOW days**— These have been booked for Cowloe and Longships so far. Cowloe will be having a space dome experience in the hall on 25.11 and Longships are having a visit from Mark's Ark who is bringing some animals into school. Miss Clackworthy is doing a site visit to Helston museum this weekend and is hoping to take the children there to look at all of the old vehicles as part of their project. We will hopefully have a date set by next week.

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


### **Important notices**

- ⇒ Free Fruit is still available each day.




