

Headteacher's Message

This week has been an unusual one for me, the most time I have ever spent away from the school since I started. I am feeling fine and looking forward to coming back to school on Monday. I want to say thank you to all the wonderful staff who have done an amazing job keeping the school going, and to everyone for their kind and supportive messages.

I did my assembly remotely on Monday, where the focus was celebrating difference. We are blessed at Sennen to have a wonderfully eclectic group of children with different strengths, interests and abilities and we discussed how we can be friends, even if we don't always agree! Children have been following this up in their PSHE sessions by looking at developing healthy relationships.

I have been receiving regular updates from school and I know that the children have continued to enjoy their topics and are settling down to their learning.
